Americanism Report:

1. Report all activities that perpetuate American ideals and uphold the principles of American Democracy. Americanism work is largely educational in character and pertains to all matters relating to the flag or patriotic education.
2. This include work done with children or adults
3. Flags must be displayed where the general public can see them easily. Flag sets on a desk in an office do not count.
4. Activities for Americanism includes but not limited to:
 - a. Members serving on local committees/boards such as Memorial day, 4th of July, Veterans Day and so forth
 - b. Members participating in local activities such as Parades, Memorial Day & Veteran's day Services, Americanism Literature Distribution, Elections-Voting, Registration, Support, Veterans (not of immediate Family)
 - c. Members/Units giving cash assistance for patriotic events.
 - d. Birthday Balls
 - e. Writing to local Officials, US Representatives and US Senators

Child Welfare and Youth Activities:

1. Report all activates done to enhance the wellbeing of Children
2. Work done with Young Marines
3. Include work with Youth Groups such as Boy/Girl Scouts or Teachers Aide, if you did not receive a wage (paycheck)
4. Donations to Organizations who specialize in helping Children should be listed on the Civics Report.

Civics Report

1. Activities done for adults who are not Veterans. Hours, money and clothing donated to worthy causes should be reported here, unless it is to a Veteran's Organization.
2. Assistance given by driving people to Doctor's office, hospital, drug/Grocery Stores. Work with Meals on Wheels, Visiting Hospitals, homes , nursing homes

Value of Miles: .14¢ Per Mile

Hours are to be submitted to the person Filling out the reports 1 week prior to the March Department Staff meeting

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3. DO NOT report activities or donations given by you to your own family members
4. Church Work
5. Report Time and Miles Driven
6. Work done in civilian Hospitals.

Rehabilitation Report

1. All work done specifically for Veterans and their families. Include time and Miles
2. Assistance given driving a Veteran and/or family to Doctor's office, Hospital ect.
3. Work Done in Nursing homes that is specifically done for Veterans
4. You cannot take credit for money given to your personal family members

VAVS Hospital Report

1. All activities and donations given to Federally funded Veterans' Administration Medical Centers. This includes volunteer time such as in the Canteen or Library and all items Donated
2. Miles driven to and from the VA facility and preparation/serving time for food made or brought.
3. Activities with veterans in nursing homes or on a VA contract. The nursing home can provide this information

Value of Miles: .14¢ Per Mile

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
